This is to advise you that a license has been issued to the person and premises designated on the reverse side.

The application filed with the Liquor Authority by said licensee sets forth your name as the owner of the building containing such licensed premises.

Under the provisions of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Law, a definite responsibility is placed upon the owner of the building containing premises licensed by the Authority.

Section 113 of the Law provides:

"Promises for which no license shall be granted. Where a license for any premises licensed has been revoked, the Liquor Authority in its discretion may refuse to issue a license under this chapter, for a period of two years after such revocation, for such licensed premises or for any part of the building containing such licensed premises and connected therewith."

If you desire to avoid action by the Liquor Authority under the foregoing provision of the Law, it is your duty to maintain an active interest in the manner by which the licensed premises are conducted so that a violation of law will not occur thereon or in connection therewith.

This letter is merely to advise you that such action may be taken relative to your premises should this license be revoked and does not imply the existence of any violation at this time.

TO: SUMMER LICENSEES  
SUBJECT: CONDUCT OF LICENSED PREMISES

STATE

It is desired to point out that as the recipient of a license for the summer season you have incurred the obligation of conducting your licensed premises in a manner consistent with the provisions of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Law.

Inasmuch as summer licensed premises are generally located in vacation resort areas, it is likely that your premises will be frequented by transient vacationers, whose behavior habits are unknown to you and your employees. You are hereby cautioned that you should take appropriate steps to insure adequate supervision of your licensed premises at all times, in order to preclude any violations occurring thereon. Your failure to do so will necessarily subject your license to disciplinary measures by this Authority and, in addition, may result in refusal to renew the license next year.

It is also desired to point out that the behavior of vacationists and transients during and after patronage of licensed premises sometimes creates problems of community relations between licensees and the permanent residents and officials of such communities. You are urged to take adequate precautions not only to preclude violations of law on the licensed premises, but also to insure as effectively as possible prevention of nuisances by patrons entering or leaving the licensed premises.

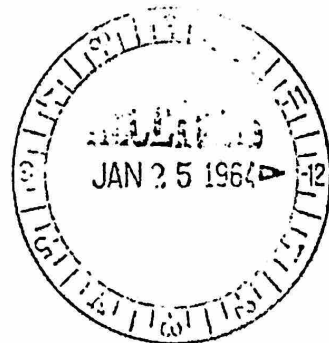

**MEMORANDUM TO ALL PARTICIPANTS**  
**FROM STUART CONSTABLE**

The issuance of liquor licenses in the State of New York, including the Fair site, is a matter within the jurisdiction of the New York State Liquor Authority. The Liquor Authority has required each applicant to obtain a license for the 1965 season of the Fair. Additionally, each applicant for a license must furnish a letter from the Fair Corporation indicating the Fair Corporation's approval of the application.

We are informed by the Liquor Authority that various participants in the Fair have not yet filed their applications for a license. It is imperative that any applications be filed immediately. We believe that you should also notify your subtenants of such requirement. To expedite the issuance of the appropriate letter from the Fair Corporation requests should be made directly to this office with a copy to the appropriate division of the Fair. We will send our letters of approval directly to the Liquor Authority.
