I have been told here that the food provided by Restaurant Associates in the vending machines at the Pavilion left much to be desired during the 1964 season.

I am told that the quality of sandwiches and other food stuffs was below standard and that in some cases unpalatable because sandwiches were said to be "moldy" and tasteless.

I think we should bring this matter to the attention of our people who renegotiate the contract with Restaurant Associates to be certain that our interests are protected and that we are provided the finest possible variety and quality of food we can get in the limited circumstances which must necessarily prevail.
