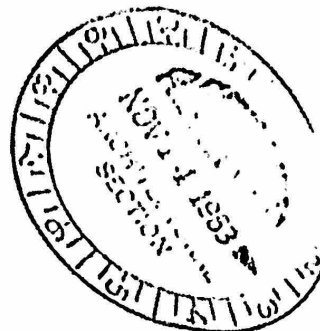

Gentlemen:

Please be advised that we have assigned the reference Job Number to incorporate the foundations for two (2) auxiliary buildings located in front of the main exits on the east and west side of the Pavilion. In addition, we shall provide electric feeders to meet the requirements as indicated on Warren G. Tyk Studio's preliminary drawing dated 11/4/63, a print of which was left with us by your Mr. Miller. We also will provide for the necessary drainage for roof leader connections on the locations indicated on the above drawing.

The location of the buildings in question and the perimeter of same is indicated on our Drawing Number N.Y.-SK-13 of which we are attaching one print.

Mr. Miller, who visited this office on Monday, November 11, 1963 with two representatives of the Warren G. Tyk Studio, instructed us verbally to proceed with the necessary additions to the working drawings. It was also agreed upon that Warren G. Tyk shall be responsible to obtain all approvals from the authorities having jurisdiction.
