Restaurant Associates, Inc.

In accordance with our conversation of yesterday and telephone discussion with George Lang of Restaurant Associates, this is to confirm our understanding that we have extended our contract with Restaurant Associates from the original opening date of April 21 to a new date of April 12, 1965.

It is also our understanding that Restaurant Associates has accepted a new \$700 per day minimum versus the original \$800 minimum of last season and that all catering activities that occur on our properties from April 12 until termination of our contract, October 17, 1965, will be treated as daily revenue.

This extension was requested as it was found to be of mutual financial advantage to Ford Motor Company and Restaurant Associates, Inc.
