Telephone Conversation with Judge Maguire 6/25/64


Ron Maguire, head of operating engineers local, got trades in Ford Pavilion together, asked for and got their support in his fight to reinstate the crib attendants.

Ford, by hiring -- through Allied -- the crib attendants, in effect granted jurisdiction to that union.

This trade is not interested in membership payments. It has a five-year apprenticeship program and is interested only in getting full employment for its members.

What Ford has done and is doing will contribute to labor strife at the Fair. I think this is a serious situation that will give Ford a lot of trouble.

The above are arguments presented by Judge Maguire in favor of re-instating the four crib attendants.
