I met with Mr. Yamasaki on Saturday, and he was extremely enthusiastic at the prospect of working with Ford Motor Company on a New York World's Fair building, or any other project.

He has no commitments whatsoever to any other concern, and would not consider now taking any other assignment until the Ford situation had been thoroughly explored. He wondered, however, if we would consider his handling a building for the Japanese Government as being competitive. I said that I wouldn't think so, but when, as and if he is approached officially, if he would check with us we could give him an answer.

Mr. Yamasaki understands that this is an informal understanding, with no commitments on our part.

He took me over to see a model he has just built for the Department of Commerce for the 1962 Seattle Fair. It is the United States Science Building, and it is simply magnificent. As soon as he has photographs of the model, he will forward them to me for our information.
